

GUEST SERVICES

Enhanced security measures remain in effect at West Point and stadium access points. Please be aware that fans will encounter security checks, including 100% identification checks at all games. Please arrive early to avoid delays.

GAME DAY CENTRAL: Visit www.goARMYsports.com for all your Game Day information.

GUEST SERVICE STATIONS: Are located along both the East and West concourses.

LOST & FOUND: Lost and found items can be claimed at the Guest Service Stations or by calling the Army Athletic Association at (845) 938-4108.

FIRST AID: The First Aid Station is located under Section 25. In case of emergency, please notify the nearest usher or the Military Police.

GAME PROGRAMS: Are available at most entrance gates.

ATMS: Are located along both the East and West concourses.

MERCHANDISE: Two merchandise stores are available on the visitor's side at each end zone. Shirts, hats, sweatshirts, seat cushions, buttons and much more is available.

RESTROOMS: Are located throughout Michie Stadium concourses.

PROHIBITED ITEMS: The following items are prohibited from Michie Stadium: food, bags (except diaper bags), backpacks, umbrellas, artificial noisemakers, laser pointers, containers of any kind, coolers, bottles, cans and animals (except service animals to aid guests with disabilities). The possession or consumption of alcoholic beverages is also prohibited inside Michie Stadium.

SMOKING POLICY: Smoking is not permitted in Hoffman Press Box, Kimsey Athletic Center, Randall Hall or the seating areas of Michie Stadium.

CONCESSIONS: Concession stands are located throughout Michie Stadium. Special delivery requests, box lunches for groups and tailgate catering can be accommodated by phoning (845) 938-7732.

PUBLIC ADDRESS: Messages for the public address announcer are accepted only for medical emergencies and must be approved by an Army athletic official.

HANDICAPPED SERVICES: Handicapped parking accommodations are located in H Lot. A handicapped license plate, state registration or handicapped parking pass is required to gain entrance to the area.



GETTING TO WEST POINT

FROM JFK AIRPORT

VanWyck Parkway to Bronx-Whitestone Bridge. After crossing the bridge, look for the Cross Bronx Expressway. Follow the Cross Bronx Expressway to the Bronx River Parkway north. Take the Bronx River Parkway to left fork for the Sprain Brook Parkway. Follow Sprain Brook Parkway to Route 287, left exit to Tappan Zee Bridge and Interstate 87 (New York State Thruway). Over bridge, take exit 13N onto the Palisades Interstate Parkway heading north. Take the PIP north to its end (Bear Mountain traffic circle). Follow signs for Route 9W north (3d exit off traffic circle). Take the first "West Point, Highland Falls" exit. This will lead you into Highland Falls, past the Visitor's Center and Museum, and through to Thayer Gate.

FROM LA GUARDIA AIRPORT

Take the Whitestone Parkway to Bronx-Whitestone Bridge. After crossing the bridge, look for the Cross Bronx Expressway. Follow the Cross Bronx Expressway to the Bronx River Parkway north. Take the Bronx River Parkway to left fork for the Sprain Brook Parkway. Follow Sprain Brook Parkway to Route 287, left exit to Tappan Zee Bridge and Interstate 87 (New York State Thruway). Over bridge, take exit 13N onto the Palisades Interstate Parkway heading north. Take the PIP north to its end (Bear Mountain traffic circle). Follow signs for Route 9W north (3d exit off traffic circle). Take the first "West Point, Highland Falls" exit. FROM NEWARK AIRPORT

Take Interstate 78 West to the Garden State Parkway. Take the GSP north to the end and follow signs for the New York State Thruway (I-87) south. Exit Thruway at exit 13N onto the Palisades Interstate Parkway heading north. Take the PIP north to its end (Bear Mountain traffic circle). Follow signs for Route 9W north (3d exit off traffic circle). Take the first "West Point, Highland Falls" exit. This will lead you into Highland Falls, past the Visitor's Center and Museum, and through to Thayer Gate.

FROM STEWART AIRPORT

Exit airport, make left turn onto New York State Route 207 to the New York State Route 300 interchange. Make left turn onto Route 300, cross New York State Route 17K to the Interstate 84 interchange. Take I-84 east to exit 10 (Route 9W). Make right turn onto 9W south. Take the second "West Point, Highland Falls" exit. This will lead you into Highland Falls, past the Visitor's Center and Museum, and through to Thayer Gate.

PARKING/SHUTTLE BUSES

To better facilitate parking, Army charges \$10 per parking pass for cars, trucks and vans, while oversized vehicles (buses, RVs) are \$20. ALL vehicles are required to have a parking pass.

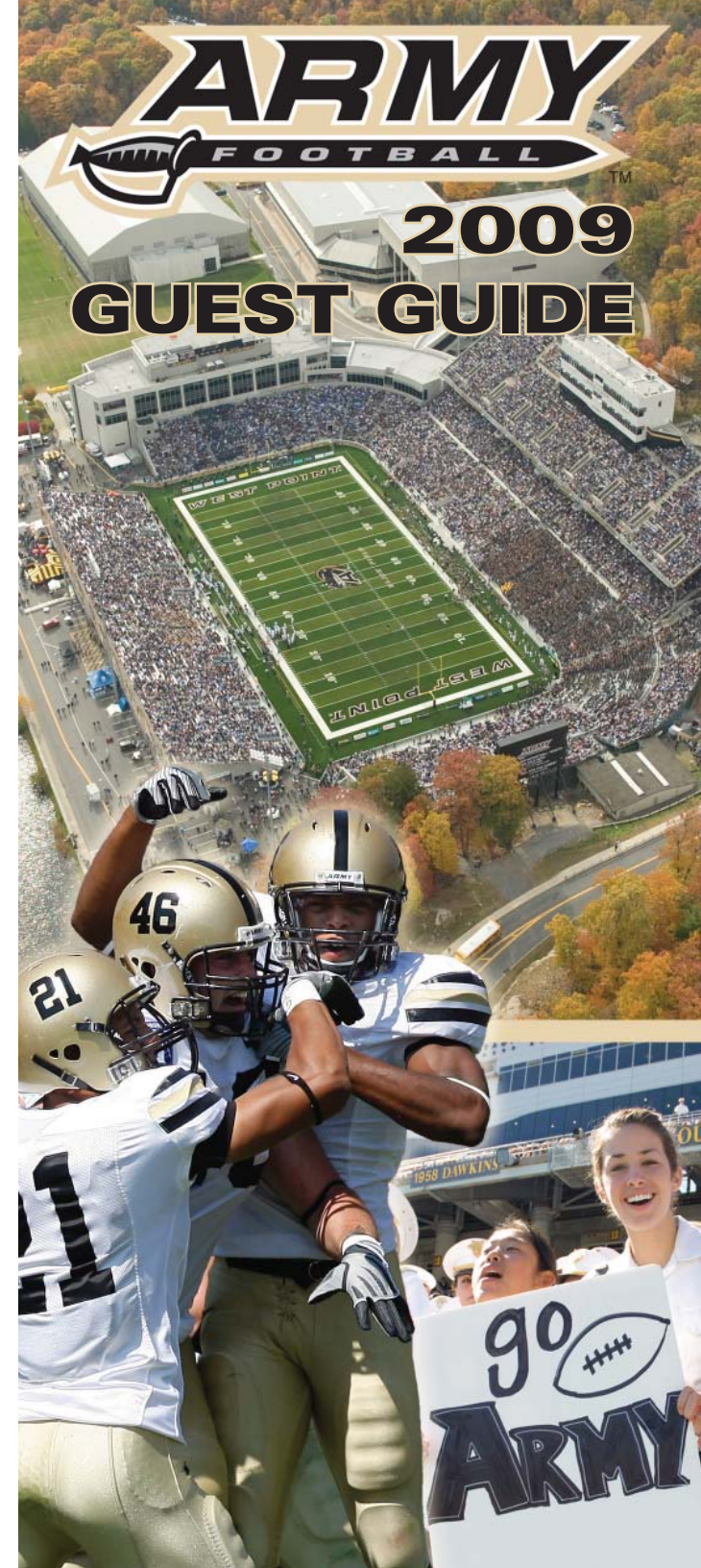
Parking passes are included with season ticket purchases and mini ticket plans. Non-season ticket holders must purchase a parking pass in advance or at the entrance gates.

Specific color passes will make it easier for fans to enter through the proper gates — Green Passes: Thayer; Red Passes: Stony Lonesome; Blue Passes: Washington. Fans with orange-colored general admission parking passes should enter through Washington Gate and will be directed to the proper parking area.

SHUTTLE BUS SERVICE

Free shuttle bus service is provided from the West Point parking lots to the parade ground and Michie Stadium. Each lot is color-coded corresponding to each color-coded bus route. Postgame shuttle bus departure points are:

- Red—Howze Field
- Blue—Flight Memorial (North end of Lusk Reservoir)
- Green—Herbert Hall (intersection of Mills Road and Howze Place)
- Handicapped—Gates 1 and 6 at Michie Stadium
- Wheelchair—Gate 6 at Michie Stadium

TICKET INFORMATION

The Army Ticket Office is open for in-person sales from 8:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday. Phone lines are open 9 a.m. to 9 p.m. Monday through Friday and from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. on Saturday and Sunday. On football game days, tickets can be purchased two hours prior to kickoff at the booths at Gates 1 and 3.

TO PURCHASE TICKETS IN ADVANCE: In person at the ticket office in the Holleder Center; call 1-877-TIX-ARMY; or visit www.goARMYsports.com.

TICKET PRICES

SEASON TICKET PLAN: \$180 per seat; includes reserved parking pass.
COACH E'S ARMY: Package includes lower deck seating in section 5-8A for all six home games; \$99 per seat; includes reserved parking permit.
FIELD GOAL PLAN: Package includes sideline seats in your choice of sections 9, 31 or U-10 for the Ball State, Tulane and Rutgers games; \$85 per seat; includes reserved parking permit.
RUTGERS/DUKE COMBO: Only \$49 per seat for both games
RUTGERS/VMI COMBO: Only \$49 per seat for both games
ARMY KICKOFF SPECIAL: Package includes home opener vs. Duke and Ball State. Get both games for only \$38.
FAMILY FUN ZONE: Package includes north end zone seats for the Duke, Vanderbilt and VMI contests; \$33 per seat; includes reserved parking permit (Four ticket minimum purchase is required).
SINGLE-GAME TICKETS: \$29 for the Duke, Ball State, Vanderbilt and VMI games; \$36 for Tulane. Call 1-877-TIX-ARMY or log on to www.goARMYsports.com for group, senior citizen and military discounts.

TICKET POLICIES

LOST, STOLEN OR MISPLACED TICKETS: Fans can receive a gate pass for lost or stolen tickets at the advance sales window near Gate 3.
RE-ENTRY: There is re-entry to Michie Stadium.
